#### West Elementary Christmas



Thanks to everyone who participated in the budget hearing this past Sunday. Next steps for the unified budget:

- December 9- Adjustments made at Unified Business Affairs Board meeting
- Adjusted draft budget will be sent to leadership of each congregation for their approval
- January 19- Congregations (FCUCC and CUMC) adopt unified budget at Unified Congregational Meeting

We have a few other leadership plans that are underway:


- Beginning this month, we are hoping to initiate unified monthly leadership meetings for both congregations, bringing the UCC Church Council and Christ UMC Leadership Team together on a regular basis
- There will be a UCC congregational meeting on January 5 following worship (see last week's newsletter for more detail)
- Plans are underway to hold a unified congregational meeting on January 19 to vote on unified leadership and a unified budget. There will be an Annual Meeting Booklet that will contain the reports of both congregations

It feels like there's a lot on our plate these days, probably because there is. It's both exciting and a bit daunting. Anytime we are faced with challenges that have the potential to lead to change, it's helpful to take some time to sort a few things out with some questions:

- What is going well that helps bring a positive light to the pending change?
- What challenges seem to be the hardest and how can they be broken down into smaller pieces?
- What voices am I listening to? Are they the voices of wisdom and knowledge or the voices of speculation and fear?
- How can I use my voice for good and not harm?
